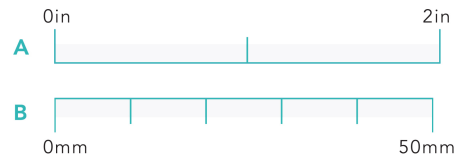

DO NOT select "scale to fit" or "shrink to fit" option when you go to print.

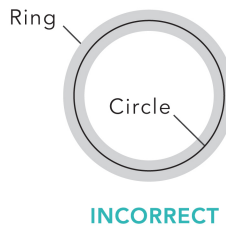
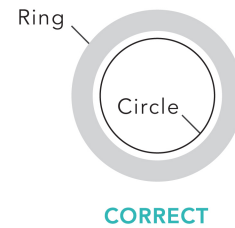
Option 1 - Measure the bars on the right to ensure your printed page is the accurate size. Line A should measure exactly 2 inches and Line B should measure exactly 50 millimeters in length.

Option 2 - Measure a quarter. The coin should fit completely over the image so that all lines are covered without the coin hanging over any edges.

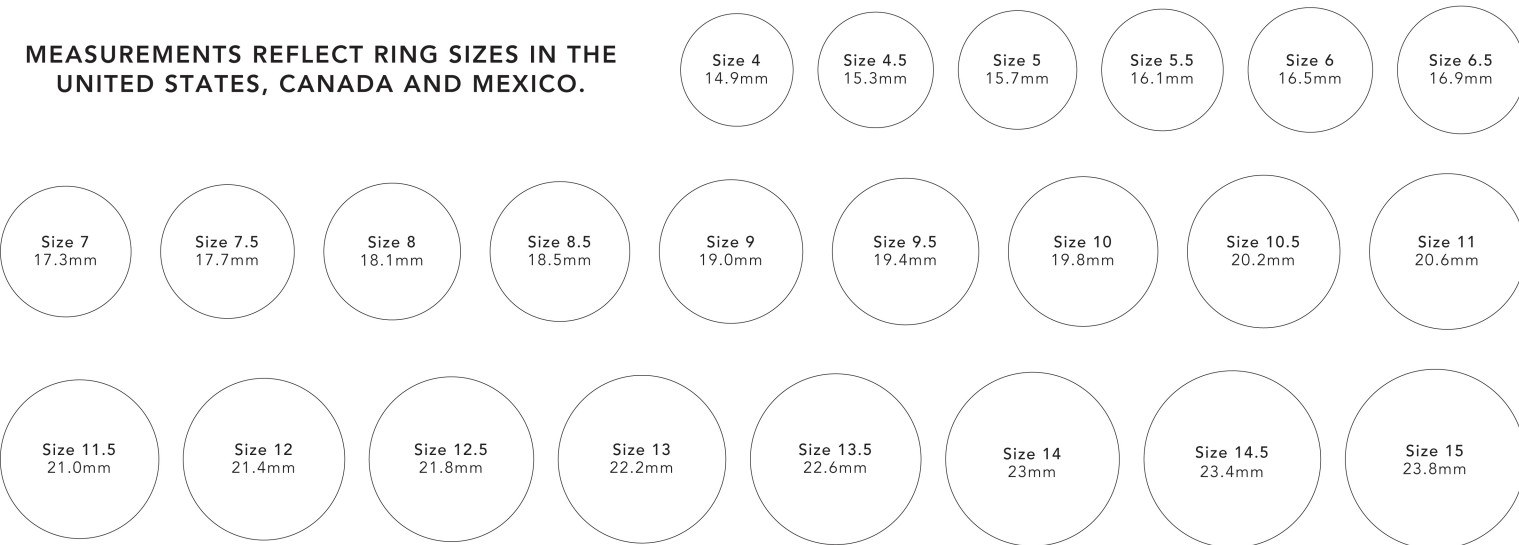


HOW TO MEASURE A CURRENT RING

- 1) Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
- 2) Match the ring with the appropriate circle below to determine the correct ring size. Place your ring on over the circles until you find the ring where the circle lies just inside your ring. If the ring covers the circle entirely, the size is too large. The correct size is found when the circle fits closely inside the circumference of the ring without touching the ring.

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR FINGER WITH PAPER

- 1) Cut out the ring sizer below along the dotted line, and make a slit as indicated.
- 2) Slip the end of the ring sizer through the slot to make a loop.
- 3) Place the sizer around your finger and pull the tab through the slot until the paper fits comfortably and can be moved over the knuckle.
- 4) Your ring size is indicated by the number that meets the line when pulled through the slot.
